How to chat on webcam with confidence

## Do You?

- Chat to people on line that you have never met.
- Chat using a webcam.
- Share pics you only want some people to see.

YES.....

.....SO WHAT?

# Webcam is not private, it can be recorded and shared.

- With the right software it's really simple to record everything that's displayed on computer screen. This includes webcam video.
- If the person on the other end records you they may share the video with people on Facebook, Twitter, post it on YouTube or e-mail it to your family.

# Abusers use videos to threaten young people

- Abusers try to force young people to make more sexual videos by threatening to share an embarrassing picture or video with their family or friends. Some have asked for money or young people to hurt themselves.

# This would never happen to me!!

- This has already happened to hundreds of young people in the UK.
- It can happen to boys and girls
- It could have happened to a friend ..... And you would never know.

# Here are the Tricks

- They often pretend to be a boy or girl your age –it's very easy to lie online.
- They send sexy pictures or webcam video of other people to get you to join in.
- You might not tell what they really want until it is too late

# Here are the Lies

- Lie : The police will never find me , I have hidden myself on the internet
- Fact : This is never true. Everybody leaves a digital footprint online. The police are very good at tracking this type of crime down. Arrests have been made.
- Lie : I'm absolutely going to share this image if you don't go on webcam for me
- Fact : Abusers don't always share images, even when they threaten to. The more they share the easier it is to get caught.
- Lie : If I share this image you'll never get over it.
- Fact : You might feel trapped but that is not a reason to do more. All problems can be resolved with time and support. There are people at school and CEOP as well as your parents to help you.

# Here are the Lies

- Lie : It's your own fault for sharing naked images in the first place
- Fact : Most people who get into this sort of trouble have been easily led ..... The abuser is the person responsible.
- Lie : There's no one who can help you. I am in control.
- Fact: There's lots of help and support out there. If you are too embarrassed to tell an adult you trust like your mum and dad you can contact school or CEOP and speak to someone. We will not judge you. We will support you and help make it stop.

# How Can I Stay Safe?

- Never do anything on a webcam you wouldn't want your family or friends to see.

# Remember !!

- Don't feel pressurised to get naked on webcam.
- If someone threatens you online, tell an adult you trust as soon as possible.
- It's never too late to get help.
- Remember – the abuser has broken the law.
