Explanatory Notes for Statement of Results Sheet

- 1. Season** – the season to which the statement refers eg spring, summer or the results statement might be for a school year
- 2. Candidate Number** – this is the pupils exam number which will be the same for every exam they sit at this school
- 3. Unique Candidate Identifier(UCI)** – this number is the unique number that identifies you to the exam boards. If you change schools or move on to college they may ask for this number
- 4. ULN** – You may be asked for this by your post16 provider
- 5. Exam Board** – This is the Board you are sitting the subject with it may be Edexcel AQA OCR or WJEC. You can get further information about the subject from the exam board website.
- 6. Type of qualification** – this is usually GCSE or BTEC
- 7. Element Code** – this will be cash-in or Subject code,
- 8. Subject Grade** - this is the overall result for that subject, i.e. your Exam Result GCSE: 9-1, NB Combined Science is a double grade here 65.
Others: P=pass M=merit D=distinction
- 9. Mark Equiv**–. For GCSEs the number in the Mark Equiv column is the total points achieved for that subject.
- 10. Points** - Def. Performance table points. Used to compare different types of Qualifications . You may have been told what points you need to secure your place at a post16 provider.
