## **GCSE results day 2022 (25<sup>th</sup> August) What's in the envelope?**

What you will receive when you collect your results – there will be several documents in your results envelope:

1. A yellow sheet of paper with your results on. This is your statement of results – GCSE certificate will be available to collect in December.

Hopefully, you will receive the grades you need to progress to your chosen option for post 16 study. Congratulations to you, remember to confirm your acceptance of your place for September.

If you do not achieve the grades expected, please don't worry, there will still be options open to you. The first step will be to contact your preferred post 16 option to discuss the situation. Then contact other post 16 providers to see what they may have available. If you need help and advice with this you can talk Dee Zammit careers advisor or the representative from Christ the King who will be in the hall on results day or email Dee at: [careers@st-columbas.bexley.sch.uk](mailto:careers@st-columbas.bexley.sch.uk)

2. A pink - Access to Scripts form – we would like you to sign this form and hand it in before you leave on results day. If after consideration of your results you then decide you would like to review an exam paper we would already have permission from you to request it. It also will enable teachers to request a copy of your exam paper, so they can use it for teaching and learning.
3. A Blue – Where next form – we would like you to check that the contact information on this sheet is correct, please write on your phone number and email and amend information if needed. We need to know where you are going “post 16” so please complete this form with as much information as you know – if you are not sure exactly where you are going please enter the options you are considering.
4. Options if concerned....this document outlines the options open to you if you have concerns that there may be an error with your results.
5. Review of Marking and Appeals form – this will only need completing if you wish to apply for a Review of Marking or Access To Script. (see options letter)
6. Green Review of Marking letter – if you have a green form in your envelope you just need to read carefully and if you agree sign, date and return to school as soon as possible (preferably before you leave on results day).
