

# CHAPLAINCY & YOUTH WORK APPRENTICESHIP

## THE PROCESS

### APPLICATION

Candidates are invited to apply for the Chaplaincy and Youth Work apprenticeship through the National Apprentice Service

### EMPLOYMENT

Candidates are employed by the Schools and Colleges as Apprentice Chaplains where in-service training will take place and the Chaplain will become familiar with the School or Colleges Mission, Vision and Ethos

### INDUCTION PROGRAMME

St Mary's University will conduct an introductory induction to the academic training and support in collaboration with the Diocesan induction programme

### ON-SITE TRAINING

Schools and Colleges will be expected to complete their normal induction for new staff, to include Safeguarding, Catholic School Mission and Ethos

### SECULAR TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

St Mary's University Training will be delivered in-person and virtual within a Hub. This will provide opportunities for the Apprentices to meet together

### CATHOLIC CERTIFICATE IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES

The CCRS gives each person a theological literacy and enables them to understand and contribute to the ethos of a Catholic school and other schools with a religious character.

### REFLECTIVE LOG

Apprentices will be asked to maintain a reflective log which they will use to develop best practice and as a resource for the assignments set.

### APPRENTICESHIP AWARD

The Apprenticeship will be awarded to the candidate after a fixed 2 years of employment and training. This can then be used as credits towards a degree apprenticeship.
